D: You should put down that we're playing at this house the Friday after that.

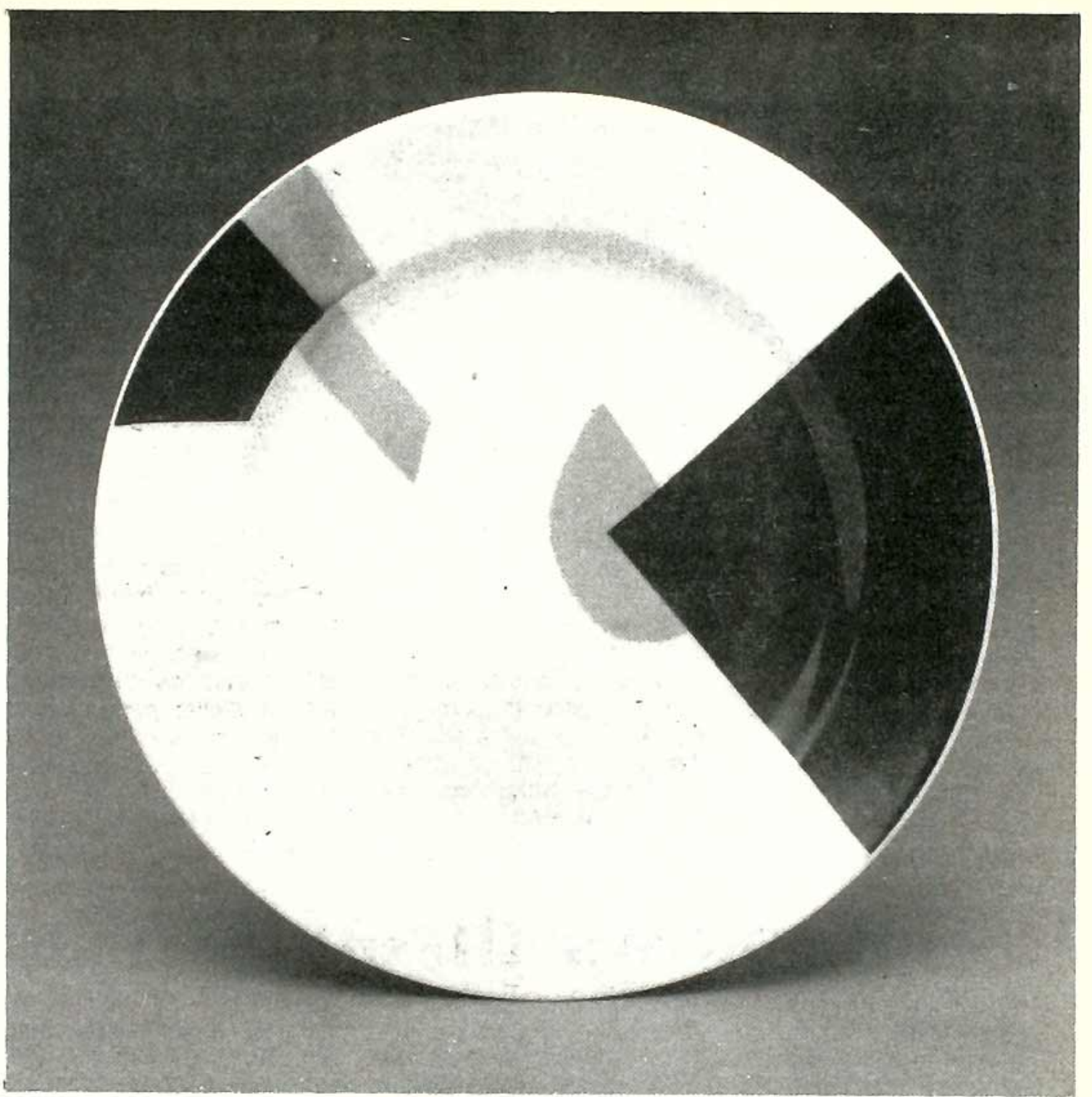
N: We're the best band in the world.
